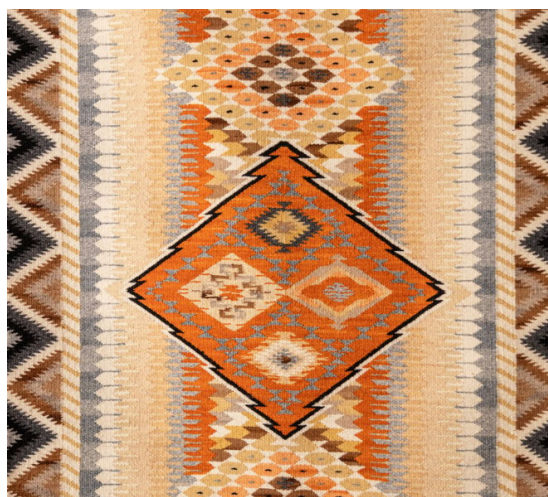

‘The Living Tradition of Chimayó Weaving’, Whitehawk





Whitehawk hosts ‘**The Living Tradition of Chimayó Weaving**’, a special exhibition from **8–11 August** during the 47th annual **Whitehawk Antique Indian & Ethnographic Art Show** in **Santa Fe, New Mexico**.

The show will feature more than twenty historic and contemporary Chimayó weavings dated to the late 19th–21st century from the Nuevo Mexicano Heritage Arts Museum collection, as well as new works by the renowned Trujillo family. Emily Trujillo, an 8th generation weaver from Chimayó, will deliver a talk, offering insight into the cultural and artistic legacy of Chimayó textile traditions.

The Whitehawk Show brings together more than 130 experts and features thousands of historic and contemporary artworks from Native American and Canadian First Nations cultures. Fine textiles, pottery, basketry, beadwork and woodcarvings from Native American and world tribal traditions will be offered.

A second special exhibition, ‘Spirit Beings in Wood: the Vibrant Tradition of Hopi Katsina Carvings’, curated by Barry Walsh, focuses on late 19th century *putsqatihu* (cradle katsinam) and contemporary examples. Hopi katsinam have undergone many stylistic changes and developments over the past 150 years, yet the art form remains true to its spiritual foundations.
